

There are so many barriers to employment after incarceration. We help our clients work around them.

We teach clients how to get a job and keep a job.

Our programs also benefit employers.



Our sites offer employment training, contacts with employers and unions, education on available benefits and services, computer training and online employment search, network building workshops, adult basic education tests, life skills training, financial literacy, and so much more.

Case Management

Clients all receive assessments by Licensed Social Workers. Case Managers assist clients in resolving barriers to obtaining and maintaining employment, such as substance abuse, mental health issues, and unstable housing. They also help clients gain access to free health insurance and referrals to continuing medical and behavioral care, clothing, food, and community programs.



Employment and Skills

Once clients have been deemed adequately prepared to obtain and maintain employment, Employment Specialists guide clients in their job search and use their network to help them find leads to suitable job opportunities.

We teach clients important employment skills, such as resume creation, job search assistance, interview preparation, workplace etiquette, criminal records workshops, resume integration with Jobs4Jersey, and more.

Legal Assistance

Our network of *pro bono* lawyers can provide free legal assistance to help clients obtain identification and resolve previously existing legal issues, such as warrants and parking tickets, which can be barriers to employment.



There are state and federal programs available to employers who hire NJRC candidates, which bring value to a company's bottom line. These include:

Work Opportunity Tax Credit

This is a federal tax credit, which reduces a company's federal income tax liability by as much as \$2,400 per qualified newly hired employee.

Federal Bonding Program

This is a business insurance policy (*free of charge*) that protects a company in case of any loss of money and/or property, due to employee dishonesty. A total of \$5,000 bond coverage would be issued to the company, with no deductible amount of liability.

On-the-Job Training

Created by the NJ Department of Labor and Workforce Development, On-the-Job Training pays an employer up to \$10,000 to cover half of the employee's wages for a period of twenty-six weeks.
