to Vote**

**To participate in the General Election,** you must be registered to vote in Middlesex County by Tuesday, October 17, 2023.

**Register to vote or update your registration:**

- Register to vote online
- Complete and mail in the Voter Registration Application
- In-person at the County Clerk's office or the Board of Elections
- While applying or renewing your driver's license at Motor Vehicles

**Ways  
To Vote**

**Return your ballot through the United States Postal Service. Mail-in-Ballots must be postmarked on or before 8 pm on election day, November 7, 2023.**

**Drop your Mail-in-Ballot in a designated Middlesex County Board of Elections drop box by 8 pm on election day, November 7, 2023.**

**Take your Mail-in-Ballot directly to the Board of Elections Office in East Brunswick by 8 pm on election day, November 7, 2023.**

**Vote in person at your assigned polling location on election day, November 7, 2023 or at a Middlesex County Early Voting Location from October 28 - November 5, 2023.**

**Vote  
by Mail**

**Voters must request a mail-in ballot in writing by filling out a Mail-in Ballot Application. A signature is required.**

**The County Clerk's office must receive Mail-in-Ballot applications by mail no later than October 31 for the General Election.**

**Voters may apply for a Mail-in-Ballot in person or by authorized messenger at the Office of the County Clerk in East Brunswick up to 3 pm the day before the election.**

**Do not give your ballot to others.**

- If someone helped you complete your ballot, they are required to sign the voter assistor portion of the yellow certificate envelope.
- If someone other than you (the voter) is delivering your completed ballot, they must fill out and sign the Bearer Section on the left-front side of the green return envelope and review the guidelines on the back of the envelope.

**Vote  
In-Person**

**Vote Early at a Middlesex County Early Voting Location from October 28 to November 5. Hours are Monday – Saturday, 10 am – 8 pm and Sunday, 10 am – 6 pm. No appointment necessary. Locations can be found online at [middlesexcountynj.gov/vote](https://middlesexcountynj.gov/vote).**

**Polling locations will be open for in person voting during the Tuesday, November 7, (6am - 9pm) 2023 General Election. If you wish to vote in person, you may do so at your assigned polling place printed on your sample ballot.**
